Dedicated to a better Brisbane

Brisbane City Council is creating a neighbourhood plan for Nathan, Salisbury and Moorooka to define the vision for the local area and to identify opportunities to manage how the area will change over the next 10 years and beyond.

Every day, Council works with residents and local communities to grow our city while maintaining the character of our suburbs and planning for the future. Neighbourhood plans help guide future development and coordinate land use and infrastructure planning. Once complete, the neighbourhood plan will become part of *Brisbane City Plan 2014*.

The Nathan, Salisbury, Moorooka Neighbourhood Plan will also help to ensure local centres continue to thrive, considering the needs of the community.

In particular, Council is working with the local community to:

- review the development potential of industrial and residential areas to facilitate employment growth and enhance liveability
- capitalise on the significant infrastructure investment in the area
- preserve the suburban and traditional character of residential areas
- protect and enhance the environment and biodiversity in Toohey Forest and local waterways
- enhance wayfinding, streetscapes and walkability between major employment hubs, residential areas, and public transport infrastructure.



CURRENT STAGE

Background research

Mid-late 2019

Council background research, technical studies and initial community engagement (26 August to 6 October 2019) to understand the key issues and opportunities affecting the area.

Draft strategy

Mid-2020

Council will seek community feedback on a draft strategy that will set the direction of the neighbourhood plan.

neighbourhood plan

Late 2020-Early 2021

Council will prepare a draft plan including specific proposals such as changes to zones or overlays, which will be reviewed by the Queensland Government and released for further community feedback.

Plan adoption

Early 2022

Adoption and gazettal of the neighbourhood plan, which will then form part of Brisbane City Plan 2014.

About neighbourhood plans

Council introduced neighbourhood planning to work with local communities on the future of their area. Once completed, neighbourhood plans form part of Brisbane City Plan 2014, and if you are a property owner, they may affect your property.
