

Adoption of Citywide amendment – Inner-City Affordability Initiative (Car parking)

At its meeting on 4 March 2025, Brisbane City Council adopted a tailored amendment to *Brisbane City Plan 2014* (Citywide amendment – Inner-city Affordability Initiative (Car parking)). The amendment applies to parts of Albion, Auchenflower, Bowen Hills, Dutton Park, East Brisbane, Fortitude Valley, Hamilton, Herston, Highgate Hill, Kangaroo Point, Milton, New Farm, Newstead, Spring Hill, South Brisbane, Teneriffe, Toowong, West End and Woolloongabba and will commence on 14 March 2025.

The purpose and general effect of the amendment is to change the City core and City frame parking area boundaries within Figure a of the Transport, access, parking and servicing code to include additional inner-city suburbs with easy access to high-frequency public transport and active transport infrastructure. Special car parking rates apply to new development within the changed City core and City frame parking area boundaries.
