Following the release of the detailed design and the completion of early works in 2022, Council is ready to start the main construction works on the Beams Road Upgrade project.

Beams Road is an important link connecting the north side and providing an essential connection as a major road in our city's growing suburbs.

Council has also continued to work collaboratively with Transport and Main Roads (TMR), as they work towards the delivery of the rail level crossing removal.

This project will deliver the necessary infrastructure investment for northside residents, making it easier to get home sooner and safer.

### What's coming up?

From mid-2023 you will see crews on site undertaking the following works:

- upgrading the Dorville Road roundabout with traffic signals and providing signalised crossings, improving safety and connectivity for people walking and riding
- widening the roadway between Cowie Road and Balcara Avenue
- providing a new shared path for people walking and riding from Lacey Road to Balcara Avenue
- upgrading services (Energex, Telstra, NBN and other communications) from Lacey Road to Balcara Avenue.

## Future works

From late 2024 to late 2025 the following works will be undertaken:

- widening the roadway from Carselgrove Avenue to Handford Road
- providing a new shared path for people walking and riding from Carselgrove Avenue to Handford Road
- constructing a new shared pedestrian underpass at Cabbage Tree Creek.

More information about the location and timing of works will be provided to residents and commuters prior to the start of construction.
